International students planning to attend Atlantic Cape Community College must verify that sufficient resources are available to cover their expenses. Student must identify all funding sources and amounts from each source, totaling a minimum of \$20,000USD to cover anticipated costs. This amount reflects the costs associated with nine months of study (tuition and fees, living expenses, books, supplies, personal and miscellaneous expenditures). The financial solvency of each international student, along with the student's academic progress, will be reviewed annually. **A completed Confidential Financial Statement AND original bank statements (no older than 30 days) showing proof of funding must be on file before Atlantic Cape can issue an I-20.**
