Charges

- Support the development, periodic update, assessment and implementation of a Campus Safety Plan that promotes attainment of the College's Strategic Plan. Goal 4 "Lead – the institution to excellence through the continuous improvement and the effective and efficient use of resources to maximize student success". This includes:
 - Developing and periodically updating an effective and sustainable Campus Health and Safety Plan to continuously improve service to the college community through campus safety, security, health and wellness initiatives (Goal 4 -Objective 4)
 - Reviewing existing campus safety and security practices, policies and procedures and make recommendations to Senior Staff on the development and implementation of the necessary strategies, projects, budget initiatives and assessment efforts to enhance campus safety, security and emergency management plans.
 - Monitoring relevant public health, safety, and compliance issues on campus and makes recommendations on how to address them.
 - Enhancing the safety of Atlantic Cape's campuses by addressing the recommendations made by the New Jersey Campus Security Task Force (October 2007).
- Submit annual goals at the start of each year based on alignment to the Strategic Plan and report on outcomes at the end of each year.
- Make recommendations for the best use of available resources during the annual budget preparation process. Budget requests will be sent to Senior Staff by November each year.
